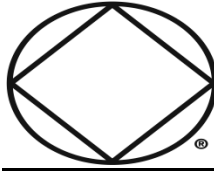

Issues presented – They are meeting in the Alano Club and have had no GSR and the Club has held their checking account. 7th tradition goes into an AA envelope. They have not had a consistent Chair or Secretary. When asked for a NA schedule I was handed an AA schedule. When I asked how B2B Area could help they said they had several needs.

1. Support from those wishing to attend.
2. They are looking for guidance on how to be self-sustaining i.e. get their checking account back.
