Turn right at the big resort directional sign onto County Road 78 (Beatty Road) and go 2¼ miles. Take a left onto Luthey Road (watch for the Camp Vermilion sign and go 1¼ miles. Turn left under the camp archway and go ¾ miles to camp.
