ABOUT LAKE VERMILION:

**With its 40,000 acres of water, 365 islands and 1200 miles of shoreline,
Lake Vermilion stretches 40 miles across the heart of Minnesota's Arrowhead Region.**

DIRECTIONS: Take US #53 to Cook, and then turn right on County Rd 24. Stay on CR 24 by taking a right at the stop sign and then a quick left after the railroad tracks. Go 3 miles. Turn right at the big resort directional sign onto CR 78 (Beatty Rd) and go 2 ¼ miles. Take a left onto Luthey Rd (watch for the Camp Vermilion sign and go 1 ¼ miles. Turn left under the camp archway and go ¼ miles to camp.
