Hospitals and Institutions Subcommittee

Mike S. read the H&I Dos and Don'ts.

Literature Report (James M. reported): We have IPs available, and up-to-date no-contact meeting lists for distribution at closed facilities.

Panel leader reports:

Dakota Co. Jail: (Mike S. reported): We obtained 7 softcover basic texts; need to get those to the contact to get them into the jail. Have 2 new people waiting to hear if they are approved for participation by the jail. Looking for one more person to share this Saturday. Todd stated that the inmates are really looking to get basic texts; they get AA books but not NA ones.

Detox (Steve P. reported): Steve didn't make it last month due to illness; he called the facility ahead of time to let them know and they said they only had 3 clients that evening.

Haven in Shakopee, evening (Brian F. reported): He didn't talk to them about the possibility of the commitment ending. He will go this month and mention that there may not be a commitment any longer if we cannot get a new panel leader.

Haven in Shakopee, morning: (Raven not present, Brain reported for her): The commitment is going on.

Journey Treatment Center (Todd V. reported): Went on Wednesday instead of Monday (due to Memorial Day); there wasn't much different than Mondays (no significant difference in number of clients), so will go back to Mondays. If they want a commitment on Wednesdays we would need to find a panel leader for that evening.

Cochran Recovery Center (Steve P. reported): Steve is still temporary panel leader. Last month he went with one other addict; have 2 people already committed to go this month. There were 23 clients at the last commitment. Please mention that we need a new panel leader for one of Steve's commitments.
