

Rules & Etiquette of the Campground

- Be respectful of your neighbors and tubers on the river
- Remain within the space of your given camp site
- Please watch your language! We are a "family" campground
- Speed limit is 5 mph throughout the campground
- Limit of 6 people per Camp Site
- Wristbands are to be worn at all times
- Quiet hours are from 11pm to 8am
- All visitors must leave the campground by 11pm **Those who fail to comply will be charged for a full night of camping**
- Fireworks are strictly prohibited and WILL result in immediate eviction without refund
- Keep your camp site neat and tidy – trash bags available at the gate
- Styrofoam and glass are strictly prohibited on the river
- NO glass or styrofoam allowed outside your camp site
- Cutting of any standing trees or branches will result in a \$200 fine
- Outside firewood is NOT allowed
- No off road vehicles allowed
- In the event of hazardous weather, report to bath houses
- In the event of any emergency, call 911 and report to the camp manager on duty

Bring your REGISTRATION FORM to the gate to get campsite marker. All occupied campsites must have a SSFA campsite marker.

PIG T-shirts and raffle tickets will be sold at the merchandise table located at the gate. **MNNAC & WISNAC merchandise will also be sold throughout the weekend.**

ARFC Concessions are sold in the Guard Shack during certain hours listed throughout the weekend. If the Guard Shack is closed you can purchase concessions in the building located at the bottom of the hill which is open until 11pm each night.

Quarters for showers can be bought at the PIG Gate, ARFC concession building or Guard Shack. \$1.00/ten minutes

If first aid is needed, find the nearest committee member to get assistance.

Pool Hours are from 9:00 am – 10:00 pm. **no lifeguard on duty, children 13 and under need adult supervision, glass and smoking is prohibited in the pool area** Pool will be closed during the main speaker

Firewood is for sale \$6/bundle – see committee members to get some delivered to campsite or visit the concession building

Tubing is \$15.00 (incl. tax) – go to the Guard Shack to pay and load up for a ride to the river (suggested to have at least four people go at one time for recovery sake). Last ride will be no later than 5:30 pm.

The Disc Golf course on the south side of the campground is free. Discs are available for loan at the concession building and maps can be found at the PIG gate.
