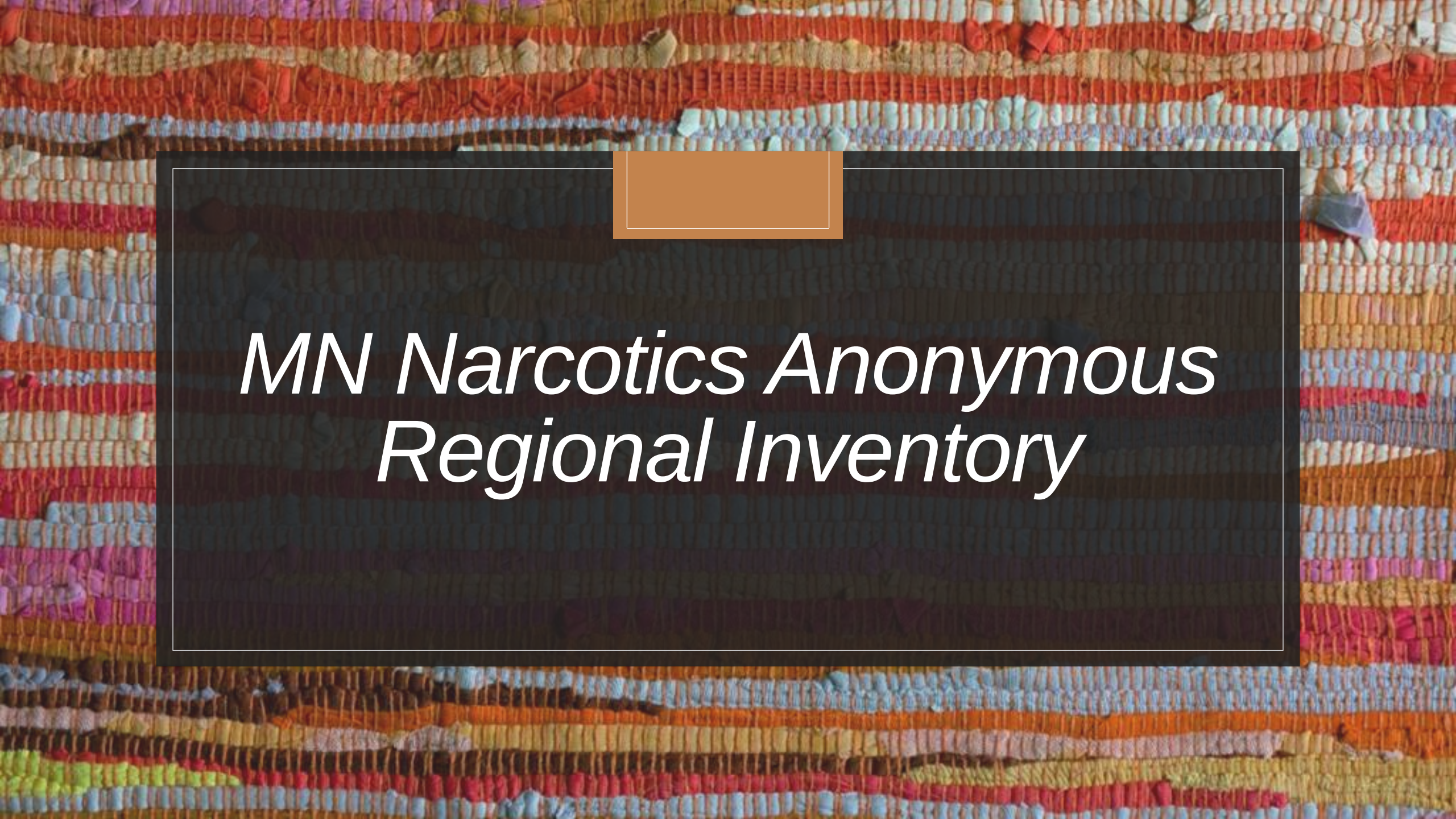




MN Narcotics Anonymous Regional Inventory
