June 5, 2014

Vice-Chair: (Jules L. reported)

- Had 8 people in attendance at the May Subcommittee Meeting; meeting went well.
- Discussed doing workshops at PIG; group decided to think about it and discuss it at the next meeting.
- Brian stepped down as H&I Chair, so we need a new one.

Region: (RCM: John S. reported)

- Minutes from the past Region meeting were 50 pages. (We won't go through it all.)
- NA Way magazine is now available online; go to <http://www.na.org/subscribe>
- Monte (current Regional Delegate) is stepping down, as he is moving to another country.
- Next World Convention (WCNA 36) is in Rio de Janero, 6/11/15-6/14/15. Can pay in installments at na.org online.
- Multi-Zonal Service Symposium will be in St. Louis Sept. 26-28, 2014. 25 regions and 3 zonal forums in the U.S. will be participating.
- World Service Conference just wrapped up in May. Our RD and RDA said that it was an amazing experience working through consensus-based decision making, but some Roberts Rules ended up being re-interjected at the end. The health of NA across the world is great. These WSC motions passed: 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13. Motions 2 & 3 failed.
- Sept. 26 & 27 – ICUCNA and conference and banquet at Ramada in Bloomington. Through June 30 can purchase ICUC conference tickets for \$20 and banquet tickets are \$25.
- Anyone is welcome to attend at region, and everyone who attends can vote and participate.
- Prison transition fairs went very well, creating much awareness of N.A.; many of the wardens want N.A. in their jails/prisons. Cost was \$1760 for all of the fairs.

- Twin Cities Pride Fair – NA booth needs volunteers; last weekend of June. Cost to Region is \$500.
- Region purchased a projector for meetings; cost \$650. (It is also available for other purposes.)
- Voted to fund \$1500 for people to attend the Multi-Zonal Service Symposium.
- Voted to create a durable table skirt with NA logo and naminnnesota.org website address for events.
- Digital Project Team – there is a shopping cart available on the naminnnesota.org website which can be used for any N.A. event for which tickets, etc. can be sold online. There is a small fee.
- Next RSC is August 9 at Seabathni.
- Open Region positions: Secretary, UMSO representative.
- UMSO (last Sat and 4th Thursday need volunteers), Bridging the Gap, Helpline, and Beyond the Walls all need volunteers.

Open Forum

- 1) Mike – Please announce that pre-registration closes on June 15 – can do so online. This is the 30th anniversary, will have a great speaker talking about historic. T-shirts are available, \$20 (only at area and at the event).
- 2) Mary – in the past, have allowed GSRs to take t-shirts to their meetings to sell.
- 3) John – Region financial report is available; to date, about \$6500 behind budget – but MNNAC income is still pending. Region makes a quarterly donation to world; whatever is left over (beyond prudent reserve) is passed on.
- 4) Melissa – PIG is an event that the area has put on for 30 years – but only 7 people showed up at the PIG meeting tonight. More help is needed – 7 people cannot put on an event for 300 people. Please announce

at meetings that help is needed!

- 5) Brian – H&I subcommittee meets on the 2nd Thursday of the month – we need help with carrying the message. Anyone with 90 days can attend an H&I commitment, anyone with 6 months may speak.

Elections

- The PIG Committee nominates Leo J. as PIG Gate Chair; nomination seconded by Brian F. Leo has done most of the PIG positions over the years, along with many area positions. Vote: Support – 8, Opposed – 0, Abstentions – 1, passed. Leo is looking for volunteers to help at gate; we need at least one person with 2 years of clean time for each 2-hour shift. Please call Leo at 612-644-6741 to volunteer.
- PIG is also looking for a Merchandise Chair.
- PIG ad-hoc meeting and inventory will be June 23; call Mike if you are interested, time and place TBD.

Old Business

1. Area Bylaws revision – concerns:
 - a. Lakeville Basic Text: Activities Chair change to 1 year – that position sometime handles hundreds of dollars, so would like to leave that at 2 years. Also would like the webmaster position with same suggested clean time as PR chair. Finally, new acronyms need to be removed from definitions.
 - b. TNT – would also vote on the bylaws with the above changes.
 - c. NA Day – Why were the changes made to clean time when they can be overridden on a case-by-case basis? Mary M. responded that in the past people have gotten very “legalistic” about the clean time requirements and turned down people because of that; the change is trying to get more people involved.
 - d. Step by Step supports as long as the acronyms are removed.
Vote: Support – 1, Opposed – 8, Abstentions – 0; motion to approve all proposed bylaws changes fails.

Nick moved that the revisions be taken back to the groups for votes on the individual changes; seconded by Chrissy and Chad. Chrissy will send out a checklist with the changes. Vote for this process motion: Support – 8, Opposed – 0, Abstentions – 1, process motion carries; group votes for the individual changes will be compiled at the next ASC meeting (GSRs please have your group's form completed before the start of the meeting).

New Business

1. Motion by John S., seconded by James M.: Donate money above prudent reserve (\$1000) at this meeting to MNRSC. Mary made a friendly amendment to make the donation amount \$250, which John and James accepted. Mary will make the donation as a check to John, who will then make it as an online donation to Region.
Vote: Support – 8, opposed – 0, abstentions – 0, passed.
2. Motion by Melissa E., seconded by Chad: Donate supplies from Keep it Simple meeting to Midweek N.A., and allow Midweek to trade back in \$142.50 of books for a \$60 literature credit. Garrett asked to amend the motion to have Midweek N.A. keep all of the literature, but donate the remaining treasury from Keep it Simple (approx. \$60) to Midweek N.A.; amendment accepted by Melissa.

Discussion: In past, a group donated literature to another group when it disbanded, so there is a precedent here; it really doesn't have to come to area.

Vote: Support – 7, Opposed – 0, Abstentions – 1, motion passed.

Motion to adjourn made by Chrissy E., seconded by Chad. Meeting adjourned at 8:45pm.
