Group Concerns & Announcements

- 1) Ties That Bind Us – Could use support from addicts with more clean time and who carry a clear NA message and will need new trusted servants ASAP.
- 2) Tuesday Night Serenity – Could use support, attendance has been 5-8 on average.
- 3) Midweek NA – Has been getting more attendance.

- 4) Rock Solid NA – Could use support from addicts with clean time and female sponsors (women's treatment center in the area attends regularly).
- 5) From Darkness Into Light – Could use support.
- 6) NA 101 – Group financial status is iffy, could use support.
- 7) Apple Valley Basic Text – Could use more support.

Open Forum

- 1) Matt K.: Question about the best way to handle something; GRINDR was discussed at meeting and group decided it would support it. Nick stated it was just something that was discussed in open forum at Region but it wasn't discussed at all at most recent meeting. It was advisory only.
- 2) Alya: Should we discuss meeting of the month, as it wasn't brought up at the subcommittee meeting? Angie asked about supporting the Northfield meetings. Rock Solid NA hasn't been MOM for a long time. Group conscience is for Rock Solid NA on January 20 at 7pm in Northfield.
- 3) Andrew: Spoke with secretary from Back to Basics area, they have a different format for their meeting list and produced one as a tri-fold, he distributed copies as an idea/consideration.
- 4) Steve P.: H&I is suffering; we have had problems with getting people and getting new people as panel leaders. Our primary purpose is to carry the message to the addict who still suffers; we need to get more support. GSRs please ask for volunteers and take down their names. Matt suggested asking people and offering rides to the subcommittee meeting or and H&I commitment. Todd stated that he would call around and ask people; it does help to reach out in person. Steve P. suggested having GSRs bring a phone list from their meeting, and ask people to check off their names if they are interested. John S. suggested having an area inventory to bring up ideas; also, some people can't afford another evening a month, so should we have subcommittee meetings the same night as the ASC meeting? Alya stated that it is a problem to have the PIG and other subcommittee meetings at the same time. Steve H. suggested having area meetings on a Saturday, with different committees at different times and the ASC meeting at a specific time. Kiersten suggested maybe doing subcommittee meetings after the ASC meeting in place of fellowship. Steve H. suggested that the area bylaws violate the 7th Concept of NA Service by not allowing committee chairs a vote at the ASC.

Elections

- Nick P's term as RCM is up; Nick stated that he has willingness to serve for another term. Vote: Support – 11, Opposed – 0, Abstentions – 0; nomination accepted.
- Alya's term as Activities Chair is up. One addict expressed interest in the position. Alya stated that Melissa E. (current Activities Co-Chair) is interested in being chair, but she has not been able to attend ASC meetings for the past 3 months due to having a college class on Thursday nights; she hopes to be at the January ASC meeting. Garrett moved to table Activities Chair nominations until January, seconded by Tim. Vote to table: Support – 6, Opposed – 1, Abstentions – 4; motion tabled. [Under Roberts Rules of Order, a procedural motion (such as a motion to table) requires only a simple majority to pass.]
- Tom J. expressed in interest in becoming Outreach Chair. Steve asked Tom if he has an NA sponsor; he stated he doesn't. Garrett L. nominated Tom to be Outreach Chair; Todd V. seconded. Vote: Support – 10, Opposed – 0, Abstentions - 0; nomination accepted.
- Tom J. expressed interest in the Webmaster position. John S. stated that we shouldn't have same person in multiple positions. Nick stated that we have had people in multiple positions simultaneously as a matter of necessity. John M. stated that it has been a lack of willingness by others. Alya stated that webmaster needs to have technical capability, we should take advantage of that ability and willingness. Brian F. stated he has taken multiple positions in the past, it has worked for him and expects it would help Tom. John S. stated there is another person interested who needs to talk with his sponsor, but it might take a little longer. Tom withdrew himself from consideration to see where it goes and allow others to step up. Steve P. stated that we don't need to rush to fill all the positions as long as we can hold meetings.

- Brian F.: PIG committee nominated Matt K. as PIG Gate Co-Committee Chair. Matt stated that from his past he was convicted of felony credit card fraud, but has now been clean for 10 years and has since taken other money handling positions within the fellowship. He has not been in jail since he has been clean, works a program and has an NA sponsor. And he is a great hugger ☺.

- Motion by Todd V. seconded by Steve P, to take a moment of silence in memory of Jules L.; Matt K. also asked to add Kristi A. All paused for a moment of silence to remember Jules and Kristi, who are no longer with us.
- Motion by Alya, seconded by Tim N.: Sound system for “Not a Christmas Party”.
Motion to: Provide \$100 to Activities subcommittee for rent and setup of a professional P.A. sound system for the event. Jason C. has agreed to provide his equipment and set-up services for the evening (a much lower rate than usually charged).
Financial impact: \$100
Discussion: Question was raised if the church has an existing PA system that would already be included in the rent. Alya said she would check to see if that is the case. Tim mentioned that the PA system at First Presbyterian Church has been problematic in the past, and wouldn't recommend just using one at Faith United Methodist Church unless we can first test it to make sure it would work for the event. Group conscience is to vote on the motion to have the money available, and let the Activities Committee decide if it is needed before the event.
Vote: Support – 10, Opposed – 0, Abstentions – 1, motion passed.

Motion to close made by Matt K., seconded by Tim N.; meeting closed with the Gratitude Statement at 8:30pm.
