With the impending launch of our website, people are starting to ask good questions.

- What is a webservant supposed to do?
- How much time is involved?
- Is there like a job description or something we can use?
- What are the qualifications of a webservant?
- What's actually involved in doing the work?
- Do they need an access code or something?
- How do they get training?

All good questions. Let me try to address them.

1. There's a draft of a webservant position description at the end of this email. Update it anyway you like. I just made it up. It's not like there's a service manual for this stuff or anything. Besides technology changes so quickly by the time the WSC got a manual approved, it would be out of date.
2. Time is kind of weird when it comes to web stuff. I'm guessing that a regular person could get by with 2-4 hours a week of volunteer time. The reason that it's weird is that the more you learn and the easier it gets, the quicker you can get things done. But then an inquisitive person wants to figure out how to do some cool thing and starts researching and pretty soon, it's like damn I've got to go to bed. Website development is like putting together a puzzle, but there's never a last piece. Wouldn't it be cool if . . . ?
3. Qualifications? We don't need not stinking qualifications. I expect that a person needs to be relatively curious about life the universe and everything. It should be natural for them to want to know how things work. If somebody is comfortable using MS-Word to put together a flyer, they could probably be a good webservant. Tenacity is a big deal too though. You have to be okay with failure and not give up when you're working on this stuff. The most common statement I hear in my head is, "Well, THAT didn't work. I wonder if this will."
4. Basic website maintenance involves creating events, maybe changing the format of the meeting list now and again as it grows. When all is said and done, it's nothing more than typing, manipulating graphics and checking the right boxes.
5. Each webservant online account with www.naminnesota.org will have access to the backend of the website where all the setup happens.
6. The Digital Project Team will hold monthly training sessions on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month from 7:00 – 9:00 pm. These will be online webinars so you don't have to go anywhere.
