Accomplishments

SSFA has added and helped finance 3 new meetings to our area in the past 6 months with a total of 22 weekly meetings serving 4 MN counties. Overall average attendance is 16 with 2 newcomers. We have 8 meetings with average attendance of 20 or more with another average of 40. All except one report being financially stable. Many report finding female sponsors a problem. Treatment centers come to our meetings on a regular basis. Some meetings report more clean time is needed.

In 2018 we switched from buying our literature/supplies from the UMSO to NAWS. The main reasons were times UMSO could not complete our order and getting there at set times was an inconvenience. Our Area stocks a ready supply of most everything on the NAWS order form at our area meeting location. The GSRs bring their monthly order to Area and it's filled at that time. Shipping is a big advantage of ordering from NAWS. Our area pays the shipping cost on all meeting orders plus there's no tax. Gina and Mike are excellent in what they do and we applaud you both. Thank you!

Our 35th Annual PIG Event is fast approaching July 19-21. This weekend campout in WI has been a huge draw for many years. We hold successful fundraisers throughout the year to help support it. Normally at end of year the excess funds from PIG are donated to our Area. We used these funds to supplement our H&I committee to purchase and distribute the Basic Text, JFT and An Introductory Guide to Narcotics Anonymous to the Dakota Co. Jail and its Drug Court. H&I brings a weekly meeting to the Dakota Co. Jail. The Detox Center was closed in 2018 where we use to also bring bi-monthly meetings. A Big Thank You to our PIG and H&I subcommittees. All our other subcommittee chair positions are filled but currently we have no Public Relations.

To continue and stay focused on our Primary Purpose. To carry the message of recovery, that there is Freedom from active addiction in Narcotics Anonymous. To be mindful of Unity and to practice Spiritual Principles in all our affairs.
