Motion 289

Motion: To remove all requirements surrounding specific activities and the budgets associated with those activities from the TCASC by-laws. Remove by-law 9.6. Revise by-law 11.2 to read: **1)** Plan and execute [4] TCA events. **2)** See 11.2; 1); b. **3)** Activities Service team is to present a yearly budget in November for approval in accordance with by-law 3.4. These changes will take effect on January 1, 2020.

Intent: To allow the trusted servants, voted on by the body, creative liberty and autonomy when planning area events. These changes will allow them to “right-size” the fiscal outputs for each event based on their collective, historical knowledge and committee group conscious in accordance with traditions 2, 4, & 7 and concepts 3, 6, & 11.

Maker of Motion: A New Way to Live

2nd of Motion: Kim O.

Pro: We have a fiscal responsibility to allow the Activity Service team the autonomy to create their own budget based off their experience and not wait a year or two to see if the new structure works or not.

Cons: 1) Doing away with the specific events could endanger events that have traditionally been popular within the area. 2) We should give the new Activity Service Team structure time to take effect and work within the current by-laws before making major changes.

Motion 290 *Time sensitive motion approved by Chair to be voted on by GSRs without going back to the groups*

Motion: That the TCA cover cost for MSSA PR table meeting lists in the sum of \$346.28 as a one-time non-refundable contribution.

Intent: To support Region PR event, proposed by the TCA at the May 2018, MNRSC and cover this overage in literature costs. We consider meeting lists to be a vital means of carrying the message to addicts and allowing them to find us.

2nd of Motion: Alex A.

Pro: The TCA has not contributed to the region since 2016 and this would give us the opportunity to give back.
